*Situate in the District of Orangeburgh, South of the Saltwater*

having such Shape, Form and Marks, as are represented by a Plat hereunto annexed, together with all Woods, Trees, Waters, Water-courses, Profits, Commodities, Appurtenances, and Heriditaments whatsoever thereunto belonging, To have and to hold the said Tract of

*Two hundred and forty*

Acres of Land, and all and singular other the Premises hereby granted unto the said *Jacob Harter* His

Heirs and Assigns, for ever, in free and common Socage

Given under the Great Seal of the State.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Know Ye, That in pursuance of an act of the legislature, entitled, "An Act for establishing the mode of granting the lands now vacant in this state, and for allowing a commutation to be received for some lands that have been granted," passed the 19th day of February, 1791; We have granted, and by these presents do grant unto *Jacob Harter* his heirs and assigns, a plantation or tract of land, containing *four hundred*

*acres surveyed for him 2 October 1799 situate in the District of Barnwell on the right bank of Water of the big saltwater River bounded by a line running N. W. by George Howard land by a line S. E. by Jacob and George Hopes land by a line by George Hopes land and by a line S. W. by Jacob Harter's land*

having such shape, form and marks, as are represented by a plat hereunto annexed, together with all woods, trees, waters, water-courses, profits, commodities, appurtenances and hereditaments whatsoever, thereunto belonging, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of *four hundred* acres of land, and all and singular other the premises hereby granted unto the said *Jacob Harter* his heirs and assigns forever, in free and common soccage.
